<b>Adoption Services</b>	<b>Who is Providing the Service</b>
Identifying a child for adoption and arranging an adoption	CCCWA and local government authorities identifies children for adoption and arranges the adoption. Barker and Shirley Yang arrange the adoption.
Securing the necessary consent to termination of parental rights and to adoption	CCCWA provides this service in conjunction with local government authorities, government-run orphanages or child’s legal guardian in a relinquishment case.
Performing a background study on a child or a home study on prospective adoptive parent(s), and reporting on such a study	The child study is provided and reported on by CCCWA in conjunction with local government authorities and/or government-run orphanages. Shirley Yang may also support the provision of this service through obtaining additional information on child from CCCWA or its designated authority per Barker’s request and translate the information as needed. The home study will be conducted and reported on by a Barker contractor, as an exempt provider of Barker, if PAPs reside in a Barker licensed state. If PAPs do not reside in a Barker licensed state, the home study will be completed by a home study agency licensed in your state.  CONTRACTED SOCIAL WORKER/HOMESTUDY AGENCY _____
Making non-judicial determinations of the best interests of a child and the appropriateness of an adoptive placement for the child	CCCWA sends official referrals to families through Barker. Barker or Shirley may make a preliminary match for a home study approved family under CCCWA’s guidelines in the China Waiting Child Program and submits it to CCCWA for review and approval.
Monitoring a case after a child has been placed with prospective adoptive parents until final adoption	Families are allowed 24 hours temporary custody of the child they are approved to adopt by CCCWA before the adoption is finalized through a registration process at the local government authority. During the 24 hours post placement period, Barker, Shirley, local government authority, and the government-run orphanage may all play a role in the monitoring of the placement.
When necessary because of a disruption before final adoption, assuming custody of a child and providing or facilitating the provision of childcare or any other social service pending an alternative placement	in a disruption situation, the government-run orphanage will assume custody of the child with the approval from CCCWA and local government authority. Barker and Shirley Yang will be available to family for support and coordination, as needed.
