Adoption Services	Who is Providing the Service
Identifying a child for adoption and arranging an adoption	ICBF identifies children for adoption and arranges the adoption. Barker, FANA, and Maria Teresa de Perez arrange the adoption.
Securing the necessary consent to termination of parental rights and to adoption	ICBF and courts secure the necessary consent to termination of parental rights and to adoption.
Performing a background study on a child or a home study on prospective adoptive parent(s), and reporting on such a study	ICBF performs a background study on a child. FANA provides current medical information on the child. Maria Teresa de Perez may also support the provision of this service through obtaining additional information on child from FANA per Barker's request and arrange translation of the information as needed. The home study will be conducted and reported on by a Barker contractor, as an exempt provider of Barker if PAPs reside in a Barker licensed state. If PAPs do not reside in a Barker licensed state, the home study will be completed by a home study agency licensed in your state. CONTRACTED SOCIAL WORKER/HOMESTUDY AGENCY _____
Making non-judicial determinations of the best interests of a child and the appropriateness of an adoptive placement for the child	Decision on referral is made at the Adoption Committee Meeting at FANA with ICBF official present. Under the supervision of ICBF and with approval from ICBF, FANA sends referrals to families through Barker.
Monitoring a case after a child has been placed with prospective adoptive parents until final adoption	Families are allowed to take custody of the child they are approved to adopt by ICBF and are only approved to proceed with court finalization after approved by ICBF. During this post-placement period, ICBF, FANA, Barker, and Maria Teresa de Perez may all play a role in the monitoring of the placement.
When necessary because of a disruption before final adoption, assuming custody of a child and providing or facilitating the provision of childcare or any other social service pending an alternative placement	In a disruption situation, FANA will assume custody of the child with the approval from ICBF. Barker and Maria Teresa de Perez will be available to family for support and coordination, as needed.
