Making non-judicial determinations of the best interests of a child and the appropriateness of an adoptive placement for the child	KWS makes official referrals to families through Barker.
Monitoring a case after a child has been placed with prospective adoptive parents until final adoption	Families travel to Korea and are only able to take placement of the child/children after the adoption is finalized through court and all documents are ready. KWS continues to provide monitoring to all cases until the final adoption and placement has occurred.
When necessary because of a disruption before final adoption, assuming custody of a child and providing or facilitating the provision of childcare or any other social service pending an alternative placement	Children are not placed in the care of adoptive parents until the adoption is finalized, if a disruption of the match were to occur prior to final adoption, KWS would maintain custody of the child. KWS and Barker will be available to family for support and coordination, as needed.
